Job Description/Scope of work

The Community Health Worker (CHW) will provide nutrition/health support to nutrition specialist and work extensively with the community at large. This position will lead the training and overall supervision of the program as CHWs conduct visits to community members (virtually and in person) to provide social support, health education, and improve access to health services, conducting feedback sessions with community and collect data for monitoring, and evaluation purposes. This position will report directly to the Team Lead.

Responsibilities

- Develop and conduct training for the community volunteers/groups on positive health practices such as safe motherhood, infant young child feeding practices and general childcare and hygiene promotion.
- Promote the awareness on social welfare such as domestic violence, alcohol, and drug abuse.
- Collect and report to the head of community health workers/social worker specific information related to the community.
- Support the identification of people with medical problem that meet with AMEF criteria and help the people in the community locate and find a hospital.
- Consolidate the link between AMEF services and the community; give advice on how to better involve the community in the activities of awareness and prevention.
- Act as a community mobilizer initiating activities such as the digging of latrines, identification of clean water source and organization of nutrition and sanitation days.
- Provide preventive health care services such as bed nets, macronutrients, condoms, contraceptives etc.
- Provide curative health care which may include the diagnosis and management of common childhood illnesses such as malnutrition, diarrhea, and pneumonia.
- Prepare weekly work plan and ensure timely implementation of the project activities.
- Support community sensitization at the clinics.

Qualification/competence

- b.) 2 years of experience in community mobilization, education, social services, or public health.
- c.) Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- d.) Training as a community health worker will be an added advantage.
- e.) Flexible to work in a team, different locations, to travel and work under pressure.
- f.) High professional discipline and moral integrity.
- g.) Proficiency in computer skill especially Microsoft word and excel.
- h.) Fluent in English and the local pidgin language.
