- Assess community health/nutrition needs and propose recommendations for appropriate intervention.
- Good knowledge in conducting malnutrition screening using MUAC tapes and the ability to identify nutrition deficiencies.
- Good understanding of SAM cases and referral pathways /procedures.
- Assist in the preparation of the regular work plan, program planning, draft schedule of consultative meetings, monitoring and evaluation activities.
